2008 SOUTHEAST SECTION ANNUAL DIRECTORS MEETING – 21 June 2007

The Southeast Directors met at 6:00 PM on Saturday, 21 June 2007 at the Comfort Inn in Clemson, SC.

- 1. FL moved to have multiple Indoor sites. KY seconded. Unanimous. We will have 7 Indoor sites in 2009: Tallahassee FL (7-8 Mar), Black Rock NC, Fort Gordon GA, Shepherdsville KY, and three Tennessee sites.
- 2. FL moved to have multiple Field sites. Ky seconded. GA voted no. SC, KY, FL, and TN voted yes. Due to gas prices, long distance traveling expense is negatively impacting our tournaments. Three sites were approved: Gainesville FL (23-24 May), Clemson SC (13-14 Jun), and Shepherdsville KY (13-14 Jun).
- 3. FL moved to have multiple Marked 3-D sites. GA voted no. SC, KY, FL, and TN voted yes. Three sites were approved: Gainesville FL (11-12 Jul), Ft Lauderdale FL (11-12 Jul), and Myrtle Beach SC. Three 20 target marked rounds will be shot: two on Saturday and one on Sunday. Host sites are to send a list of targets available to the Councilman (small, medium, large). The Councilman will provide distances to be used on the two 20 target ranges. It was suggested that we shoot low offset 12's on Saturday and high offset 12's on Sunday. Flighting will be based on the first round on Saturday morning, so large divisions will be assigned to a specific range. The 14 ring will NOT be in play.
- 4. The Councilman presented 9 agenda items that had been sent out to the directors ahead of time. The directors approved submitting those items and asked the Councilman to write two more: One to require inside out scoring on indoor X-rings, and another to provide a modified unit rule for awards at National and Sectional Tournaments.
