When they come to their first NFAA field tournament they get very confused by the rules which to them seem to change on each target. A lot of them get turned off with NFAA field archery because of the rules, possibly having lost points when they shot out of sequence or the wrong target. We need to keep our archers so the changes are being suggested to make our shooting rules easier for the novice/new field archer to understand.
