NFAA HEADQUARTER TO MOVE

NFAA Council unanimously accepted Yankton, South Dakota's offer to mover their Headquarters to Yankton, South Dakota.

NFAA is receiving 39 acres of land inside the city limits and located about a block off of US Hwy 50 on a road that will probably have a name change to "Archery Road". The property is partially wooded and includes the land used for this year's National Unmarked 3-D. The property backs on the Nebraska/South Dakota border which is a former river channel of the Missouri River... There is also a strip of woods (about 16 acres) to the East that they can get permission to use. The land being given to NFAA has a value between \$200,000 and \$400,000. The cost of building an NFAA building (which can be completed by the end of the year) will be around \$250,000, and the purchaser of NFAA's property in California is ready to close whenever NFAA is ready. The City of Yankton has an ordnance that bows can be shot inside the city limits on an NFAA approved archery range.

Those of you who have been to Yankton... the land is behind the Super 8 and Best Western Kelly Inn properties.

Next year's (2008) NFAA Field is in Yankton from 21-25 July (a 5/3 tournament)... the 2008 NFAA Unmarked 3-D is also in Yankton on 19-20 July.

Bow Hunting News

If you assume that you're hunting a quality Florida Wildlife Management Area in Florida. Think again. The below question was asked via e-mail to the Florida Wildlife Commission on 9/25/2007. This is not only happening at this Wildlife Management Area but also happening on other management areas throughout Florida.

Is it true that trappers have been in Green Swamp Trapping Feral Hogs this year (2007) prior to the Archery hunt?

If so, WHY? I heard they trapped over 250 hogs out of Green Swamp. I would hate to hear that this is true since us hunter pay for our license to hunt and someone else is STEALING OUR GAME

Ms. North:

The short answer to your question is yes, the Southwest Florida Water Management District has been trapping hogs on Green Swamp this year. I'm not sure about the total number of hogs trapped.

As you may know, the Southwest Florida Water Management District (District) is the lead manager of this property and the Florida Fish and Wildlife Conservation Commission (FWC) assists, as a cooperator, with the management of Green Swamp through a contractual agreement with the District. The partnership between the District and FWC has provided the hunters of Florida with hunting opportunities on thousands of acres for many years. FWC and the District view hog hunting not only as a recreational opportunity for hunters, but also as a valuable component of land management efforts.

The District, the lead manager of the property, is responsible for the land management program on Green Swamp. As the land manager, the District utilizes a variety of management techniques which may include management of the hog population. The District, as well as any other public land manager, has the authority to utilize trapping as a hog management technique to achieve land management objectives.

FWC has and will continue to encourage the District to manage hogs with a public hunting program. However, at this time the District is not supportive of increased hunting opportunities. Feel free to give me a call if you would like to discuss.

BOW WEIGHT: Compound bows are restricted to 60# draw weight maximum!

ARROW SIZE: Arrows are restricted to a maximum of 9.3 mm shaft diameter. With aluminum shafts, this would include all shafts of 23 diameter except the 2317. Shafts currently produced in the 23 size

category and legal under the 9.3 mm rule are the 2312, 2314, and 2315 (as of 1 April 2001). Anything larger is not legal.
