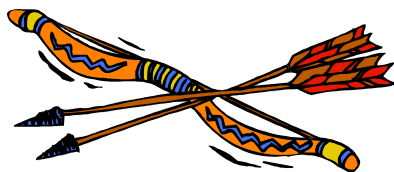

Ron served a period as Secretary of Ridge Archers in Lakeland. Ron last shot at the 2005 Sunshine State Games. He was Olympic Recurve FAA Champion at the 2004 Indoor and Target, and at the 2005 NAA Indoor and NFAA Indoor. He received Champion awards in Traditional skill at the 2002 NAA Indoor and the 2002 Southeast Sectional Field.

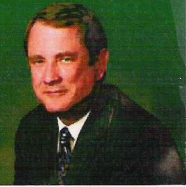
