Greetings. We have added a new category for Shooter of Year. Unsighted Single String. This would be styles - Barebow Recurve, Traditional and Longbow. Hope to see a lot of competition.

We have two people who want to represent the Central region so we are going to have an election. The incumbent David Ireland who is President of Citrus Archers and Heath Baulac who is President of Central Florida Archers. To vote you must have membership that is current as of the State Field and must be a resident of a county in the Central region or have your primary club membership in a central Florida club.

We are having a successful indoor season and hope to see you at a shoot. We have split the indoors in more locations to make it easier to compete. Sadly, a lot of the sites are outdoors but there are not many indoor locations in Florida and we have to make do. Talking to archery friends in Arizona - they have the same problem. High rents and not enough usage. We are having two dates for the NFAA face (Blue) Indoor. Most are the first weekend on February (Adventures, Ft Lauderdale, Lee County, Central Florida and Citrus). The second date is the third weekend of March at East River. Consider shooting both. Either a different age bracket or a different style. Olympic Recurve can register Limited Freestyle and Barebow Recurve can register Barebow Compound or Traditional (if their indoor anchor qualifies) with their same equipment. Limited Freestyle and Barebow Compound do not require compound bows. Freestyle can shoot Bowhunter Freestyle (just take the lens out of your scope and have a short stablizer)

. The NFAA National Indoor is the third weekend of February and we wanted to have shoots for archers who are attending. Unfortunately, the National Indoor is in Chicago. A unanimous selection by the Council since it was the only site offered.

We are also offering more one day shoots with an option to shoot on Saturday or Sunday (if you want to shoot both days, a second registration is available). Motels have gotten really expensive and with all of the available shoots in Florida it makes it hard to attend shoots. One day shoots are (Field, 900 and Classic 600). Of course, the Indoors and 3-D's are also available to shoot in one day.

Among the 10 records broken on the Archery range were two new records by 90-94 age group shooters.

Anna Hartman, of The Villages (pictured at right), set her fourth age group record in the 90-94 age group Women's Barebow Recurve event. She also set the Barebow Recurve records in the 75-79 age group (2012), 80-84 (2014) and 85-89 (2021). Richard Hanlon, from Fort Meade, broke his own record in the Men's 90-94 age group record in the Men's Barebow Compound, set in 2022. He shattered his previous record by 25 points.
