Shooting The Florida Senior Games 2010

With some folks, archery is a year round sport. For me, target archery springs up as a "totally new" obsession in the fall most years and usually wanes again when the Florida temperature rises above 90 degrees.

Two things about archery that are difficult to deal with, are that all changes for the purpose of improving your score are not guaranteed to improve your score, and secondly, regardless of prior measurement and documentation, almost any change, no matter how small, is an immutable commitment to the process of reacquiring exact sight marks. To shoot a tournament, I need a well tuned bow, exact sight marks, familiarization time shooting the newly tuned bow, and time shooting with my brain in "tournament mode" which cannot start during the tuning or sighting-in phases.

I was able to shoot two separate 900 rounds for practice before the Senior games this year. Both rounds, I felt really good about my shooting, but had scores within a point or two of my average score in 2009. It was not looking like tuning the bow had any effect, good or bad on my score, but I felt good - stronger than previous years and more ready.

My wife and I chose to stay at the Hampton Inn & Suites Colonial Blvd. in Fort Myers. The location is brand new, and sits a block from one of our favorite chain of restaurants, "Miller's Ale House". With free Internet, we could stay in touch and check the Weather Underground's hourly predictions for temperature and wind. The free breakfast was hot, plentiful, and tasty.

The venue for the 2010 Florida Senior Games was the Lee County Sherman Soccer Complex again this year. This is one of the few archery venues that does not have an RC airplane facility next door, so the only noise came from seniors bragging before the tournament began. Tim Austin and Bob Jones and Lee County Archers had organized everything to perfection. They put lines down, lane markers out, and brought the state stands and butts from Fort Lauderdale Archers in good condition. There were 25 targets set up, each with a "replacement center" face ready for the archers to practice. Tim always has "the boards" out with each archer organized by age group and shooting style.

Checking in involved signing the Florida Sports questionnaire and release, collecting your shirt and goodie bag, finding your name on "the boards", noting your lane assignment and your score card number, then grabbing the two pre-labeled scorecards from your numbered slot in the scorecard holder box. This process went very smooth, requiring only five minutes.

Shooting a couple practice ends held the first surprise of the day; I had to move my windage in one full turn and add two tenths to my elevation to put me back in the center at 60 yards. Perhaps my practice sight marks were influenced by the wind more than I had realized. There was no wind, to speak of, during the practice ends, and while the temperature was just breaking 50 degrees F., the sun was already warming to the point of needing to shed layers.

My 60 yard ends turned out very consistent with five ends of 55 points, but not a single "X" among the arrows that wandered inside the "10" ring. I put one arrow in the 8 ring in four out of the five ends. I watched to see if it was perhaps the same arrow, but the "8" arrow from one end became a "10" arrow the next, so I could not accuse the arrows. The sad reality - I was shooting 8" to 10" groups at 60 yards. Sometimes there were four arrows that would clearly group, but "they decided" to gather high in the "9" ring, with the other two arrows below the group in a vertical line, thus leading me to think maybe I was settling into a good routine, but the failure to creep tune was extracting its toll. Since I knew that pulling hard in the stops would cause my arrows to land lower, and my sight marks were not derived by pulling hard into the stops, I was afraid to play around with anything during the real shoot. I just continued to try and shoot without thinking too much.


The first 50 yard end brought two much hoped for "X" arrows, and hearing them scored was exciting: "X.X.Ten.Ten.Ten." but then the spell was broken as I heard ".Eight". Still it was a 58, with a good grouping in the center for a change. All that goodness must have gone to my head as the next end was bereft of "X"s and produced the only "7" arrow I would shoot that day, resulting in a 54 - worse than 60 yards. I resolved to make sure I was aiming at the center, and not just shooting when the dot is "somewhere in the gold". This seemed to help and even produced the first of three "almost 6 tens" ends. I had a flashback to shooting in my youth, when I proudly received a National Archery Association "Six Gold at 50" pin from an American round at a Philadelphia Lawn Bowling, Cricket, and Archery Club tournament. The world is chasing "likes" on Facebook, but I'm dreaming of a little "Six X" hat pin. Archers really are a different breed, no?

The move to 40 yards brought higher expectations. In the expectation of three or four archers on my target, all putting most of their arrows in that center six centimeter circle, I had purchased a second dozen arrows. As it turned out, I didn't end up using even a single spare arrow, and my arrows had a hard time finding that center circle. The first three ends at 40 were exactly the same scores as the last three ends at 50 yards, with only the lack of an arrow in the red "8" ring confirming that 40 "should be" easier than 50 yards. Then in the next to the last end of the tournament, after averaging 58 points for the last six ends, I dropped one into that red ring, and had difficulty grouping in the center, resulting in a 55. That end was disappointing, but renewed my intensity for the final end. I finished up the 40 yard ends with a 59, which meant my 40 yard score was two points better than my 50 yard score. Rather than think I did poorly at 40, I did outstanding (for me) at 50.

While Tim and Bob organized the results for the 83 archers, everyone stowed their gear, then gathered to the covered tables. Since the Senior Games have five year age brackets (from age 50 up to one archer age 89 this year) there are a lot of categories, (37 this year), and a lot of medals to present. 65 persons took home medals, ribbons, and smiles.

This was my third Senior Games tournament. My first Senior Games, in 2007 I was still shooting Olympic recurve, I took home a silver medal for my category. My second Senior Games, in 2008 I had just that year switched to shooting a compound, but still took home a bronze medal for my category. This year, I completed the medal collection with a gold medal. Looking at the results, which lists each archers' age, I see a really good shooter will be joining my category next year. I better start practicing now.
