

2. Minutes of previous meeting were approved. CLOSED

3. The financial report was discussed. FAA Secretary moved for permission to buy a desk chair for use in the FAA Office. NAA Representative seconded the request. Approval granted by the Board. Financially report then unanimously approved. CLOSED

New DRESS CODE

1. All athletes and coaches must present a professional, athletic appearance while on the field. (Torn, ripped or badly faded clothing articles are not allowed.) Clothing may be of any color.
2. No camo or blue denim (jeans) may be worn at target events. Accessories such as trim on shirts, caps, quivers, armguards, footwear, etc., are permitted to be camo. At field events, denim may be worn but camo may not be worn.
3. Shorts, skorts and skirts must not be shorter than finger tip length while standing normally.
4. Men and women are required to wear upper garments covering the front and back of the body and covering the midriff when at full draw. Women's upper garments shall have a minimum strap of 3" or sleeves. Men's upper garments shall have short or long sleeves.
5. Sport/athletic shoes are recommended to all athletes and coaches during target events. Shoes must cover the entire foot.
6. At no time will any athlete or coach wear any article bearing any image or language to be considered offensive to others.

BOW WEIGHT: Compound bows are restricted to 60# draw weight maximum!

ARROW SIZE: Arrows are restricted to a maximum of 9.3 mm shaft diameter. With aluminum shafts, this would include all shafts of 23 diameter except the 2317. Shafts currently produced in the 23 size category and legal under the 9.3 mm rule are the 2312, 2314, and 2315 (as of 1 April 2001). Anything larger is not legal.

No electronics!

BAREBOW: Barebow division is limited to recurve bows. (Compound Barebow shooters will be classified Compound-Fingers). [Unbraced bow complete with accessories must be capable of passing through a hole or ring of 12.2cm inside diameter +/- 0.5mm] (that's approximately 4.8 inches) -- No stabilizers and no draw checks (no clickers).
